GOVERNING LAW & CONTRACT INTEGRATION

GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION: This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Texas. Any disputes arising under this Agreement shall be resolved in the courts of Texas.
